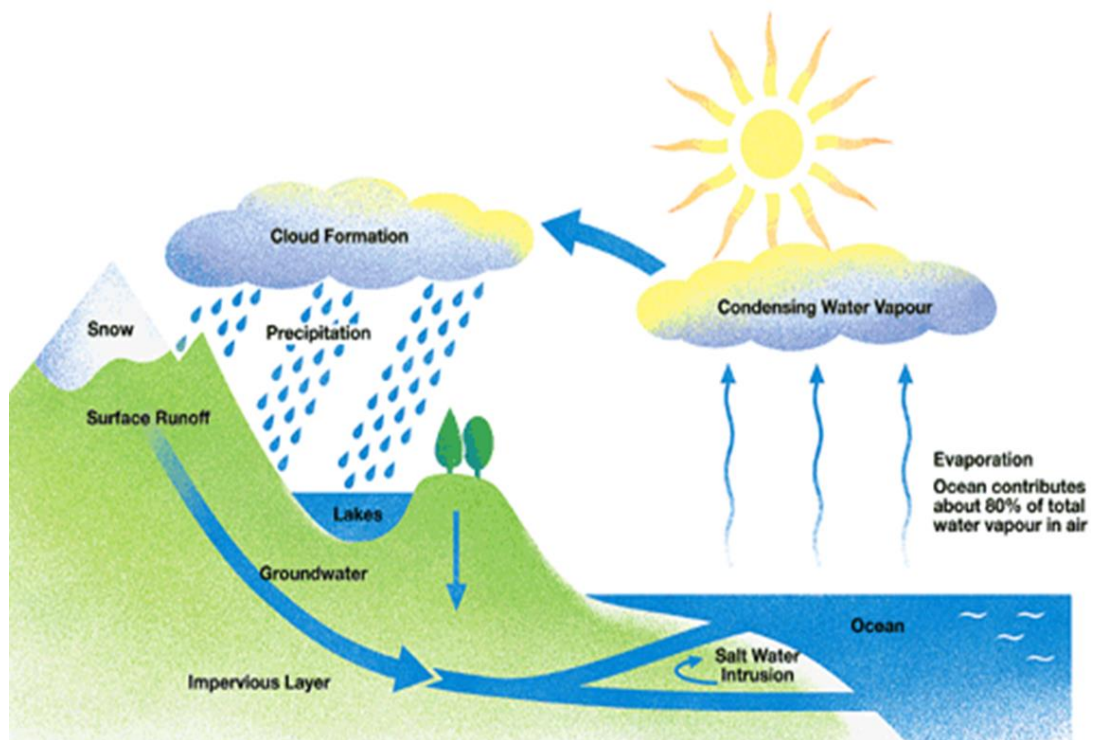




*22 of March: World Water Day*
